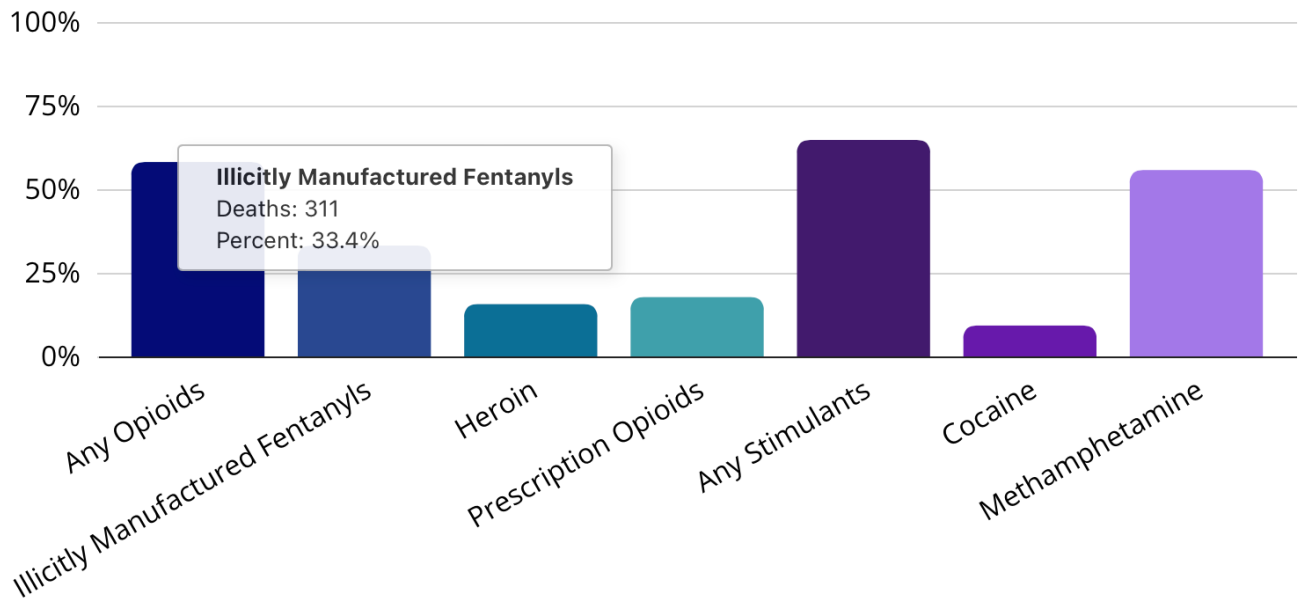


**MEMO - NEVADA** | Border Crisis

**NEVADA BORDER AND DRUG FACTS**

- **DACA Recipients:** 11,270
  - as of 12/22 per CBP
- **Foreign Born, Non-Citizens in Nevada:** 265,468
  - Per 2021: ACS 1-Year Estimates, US Census Bureau
- **Estimated # of Illegal Immigrants in Nevada:** 210,000
  - Nevada has the highest percent of illegal immigrants compared to their state population (7.1%)
    - 66% of illegal immigrants in Nevada are of Mexican origins.
  - As of 2016 (latest data available), Pew Research
- **Illegal immigrants make up 10.6% of Nevada's labor force.**
  - **Industry with the most unauthorized illegal immigrants:** Leisure/hospitality
  - **Industry with the largest % of workers who are illegal immigrants:** Agriculture
  - **Occupation with the most illegal immigrant workers:** Service
  - **Occupation with the largest % of workers who are illegal immigrants:** Farming
  - As of 2016 (latest data available), Pew Research
- **Nevada 2021 Overdose Deaths:** 932
  - Data from the CDC's SUDORS Dashboard
- **58.4% of deaths involved at least one opioid** and 65% involved at least one stimulant. (see chart below)
  - **Illicitly manufactured fentanyl was the most commonly involved opioid.**
  - The most common stimulant involved in overdose deaths was methamphetamine.

- **33.4% of overdose deaths in Nevada involved illicitly manufactured fentanyl.**

- According to the CDC, in Nevada (2021) **70.2% of drug overdose deaths** had at least one potential opportunity for intervention.
