

OHIO BORDER AND DRUG FACTS

- DACA Recipients: 3,550
 as of 12/22 per CBP
- Foreign Born, Non-Citizens in Ohio: 269,695
 - o Per 2021: ACS 1-Year Estimates, US Census Bureau
- Estimated # of Illegal Immigrants in Ohio: 90,000
 - o As of 2016 (latest data available), Pew Research
- Illegal immigrants make up 1% of Ohio's labor force.
 - Industry with the most unauthorized illegal immigrants:
 Manufacturing
 - Industry with the largest % of workers who are illegal immigrants: Agriculture
 - Occupation with the most illegal immigrant workers: Service
 - Occupation with the largest % of workers who are illegal immigrants: Farming
 - o As of 2016 (latest data available), Pew Research
- Ohio 2021 Overdose Deaths: 5,406
 - Ohio has the 5th highest overdose death rate (age-adjusted per 100,000) of any state at 47.8.
 - Data from the CDC's SUDORS Dashboard
- **85.7% of deaths involved at least one opioid** and 54.1% involved at least one stimulant. (see chart below)
 - Illicitly manufactured fentanyl was the most commonly involved opioid.
 - o The most common stimulant involved in overdose deaths was cocaine.

• 80.1% of overdose deaths in Ohio involved illicitly manufactured fentanyl.

- According to the CDC, in Ohio (2021) **53.5% of drug overdose deaths** had at least one potential opportunity for intervention.
