IMPORTANCE OF CITIZEN-ONLY VOTING IN ARIZONA

WE MUST ENSURE THAT ONLY U.S. CITIZENS ARE ALLOWED TO VOTE

- The U.S. electoral system is designed to give every eligible U.S. citizen in every state a say in choosing our leaders at the federal, state, and local levels.
- The federal National Voter Registration Act requires that states take steps to ensure that only eligible citizens are registered to vote.
- Due to the failure of the Biden-Harris Administration to secure the border, states must work even harder to ensure that their elections are not compromised by illegal aliens casting votes.
- Over <u>12 million</u> illegal aliens, including known "<u>gotaways</u>," have entered the country since 2021.
- Further, the Biden-Harris Administration issued Executive Order 14019, <u>directing all federal agencies to register voters</u>, including many federal agencies that interact regularly with illegal aliens.
- These unprecedented efforts put even more responsibility on states to protect the integrity of their elections.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Arizona is home to <u>at least 250,000</u> illegal aliens, and this does not account for the major influx of the last 3 years.
- Arizona has a <u>population</u> of **7,151,502**.
- 250,000 illegal aliens represent 3.496% of Arizona's population. Though this seems like a small fraction, it's enough to make a difference in close elections.
 - During the 2020 presidential race, Arizona was decided by just 10,457 votes.
 - o During the 2016 presidential race, Arizona was decided by just 91,234 votes.
 - o During the 2012 presidential race, Arizona was decided by just 208,422 votes.

ARIZONA MUST TAKE STEPS TO ENSURE ONLY CITIZENS VOTE

- Governors should issue an <u>America First model executive order</u> to enforce state election laws and ensure that only eligible U.S. citizens vote.
- State election officials should conduct regular voter roll maintenance for transparency and accountability.
- Voters should support ballot initiatives to enshrine citizen-only voting in their state Constitution and elect officials who will enforce it.
