


THE BIDEN-HARRIS ADMINISTRATION'S RECORD LOW REMOVAL RATE OF ILLEGAL ALIENS



3,500,000 FY17-23: Nationwide Illegal Immigration vs. Total Removals



Over 175%

FEWER ILLEGAL ALIENS REMOVED DURING THE FIRST THREE YEARS OF THE BIDEN-HARRIS ADMINISTRATION COMPARED TO THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION.

Over 300%

MORE ILLEGAL ALIENS "ENCOUNTERED" NATIONWIDE DURING THE BIDEN-HARRIS ADMINISTRATION THAN THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION.

DEBUNKING THE DECEPTIVE CLAIM THAT THE BIDEN-HARRIS ADMINISTRATION HAS DEPORTED A RECORD NUMBER OF ILLEGAL ALIENS

CLAIM: "Throughout the last three fiscal years, a majority of all southwest border encounters resulted in a removal, return, or expulsion. Over the past year alone, we have removed or returned more than 750,000 people, more than in any fiscal year since 2010." – DHS Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas

FACT: This claim <u>conflates interior enforcement</u> (removals) with border turn-backs (returns and Title 42 expulsions). The most accurate data to establish an administration's immigration enforcement record is **removals** because that data accounts for the removal of illegal aliens from American communities.

FACT: Each year during the Biden-Harris Administration, the **removal rate has been less than 5%** of the number of illegal aliens "encountered" at our nationwide borders.

FACT: The Biden-Harris Administration has <u>removed fewer illegal</u> aliens each year than the Trump Administration did in FY2020 when COVID-19 restrictions disrupted the globe and the removal process.
