## THE ISSUE

In 1984, President Ronald Reagan famously asked the American people, "Are you better off now than four years ago?" Back then, the American people answered yes resoundingly.

As the president prepares to deliver this State of the Union Address, it is critical the American people ask themselves that basic question, "Are you better off now than you were during the Trump administration?" When it comes to the economy, personal finances, crime, immigration, and world affairs, the answer is a resounding "NO!"

During the Biden Administration, Americans have endured record-high inflation, out-of-control crime across major U.S. cities, new wars and global instability, and an unmanageable number of illegal immigrants crossing our porous border. Compare that to during the Trump Administration – pre-pandemic – America's economy was booming, our cities were safe, there were no new wars due to peace through strength, and the border was becoming increasingly secure. The policy differences between administrations could not make this clearer, and as our survey shows, Americans feel the same – our Nation needs the policies that put Americans first.

#### **APPROVAL RATINGS**

- **★** According to the RealClearPolitics Average, the American people overwhelmingly disapprove of Joe Biden's performance in office.
  - **55% disapprove** of Joe Biden's job performance.
  - Nearly two-thirds (66%) of Americans think our country is on the wrong track.
- ★ Americans don't like Biden's handling of just about every major issue, according to RCP Average.
  - **57% of Americans disapprove** of Biden's handling of the economy (-18% compared to those who approve).
  - **62% disapprove** of his handling of inflation (-25%).
  - **65% disapprove** of his handling of immigration (-33%).
  - **55% disapprove** of his handling of crime (-16%).
  - **59% disapprove** of his handling of foreign policy (-22%).
    - 56% disapprove of his handling of the Israel-Hamas conflict (-21%).
    - **53% disapprove** of his handling of the Russia-Ukraine conflict (-10%).
- **★** For all the talk about political division in our country, Americans are united about one thing—we are worse off than we were in 2019 (KAConsulting).
- ★ Most Americans are worried about being able to afford groceries, filling up at the gas pump, and making their paychecks stretch to cover the basics of everyday life.
  - **Nearly two-thirds (63%)** think the economy is worse.
  - Two-thirds (66%) think the situation at the southern border is worse.
  - 3 out of 4 think the risk of war is worse.
  - 6 in 10 think the threat of terror is worse.
  - Two-thirds (66%) think crime and their safety is worse.

- ★ When asked what is the first thing that should be done to lower prices, talk about lowering energy prices.
  - "Nothing has done more to decrease poverty across the world than access to low-cost energy and free-market capitalism. Increasing the supply of energy will lower inflation, lower food costs, and put our Nation back on the path to prosperity." # **ECONOMY/INFLATION**

- ★ Economic statistics are not going to change how people "feel." They feel worse off every time they go to the grocery store or gas station or look at the bank balance at the end of the month.
  - People can't afford Bidenomics—and they know it.
    - Prices have skyrocketed three times faster under the Biden Administration compared to the previous administration.
    - Gasoline still costs, on average, \$3.52 per gallon (\$1.13 more per gallon than when the Biden Administration took office).
    - Groceries cost 21% more than in January 2021.
    - 75% of working-class Americans say they cut back on entertainment and eating out last year due to high prices.
  - **Nearly half (45%)** say "Bidenomics" has mostly negatively impacted them and their families, and **just 1 in 4 (26%)** say "Bidenomics" has mostly positively impacted them or their families. (KAConsulting)
  - **Most Americans**, including a majority of Hispanics, Independents, Moms, and Suburban voters, believe "Bidenomics" has "delayed the American Dream." (KAConsulting)
  - More than half of Americans think they and their families were better off financially under the America First policies of the previous administration. (KAConsulting)
  - It's a fact that, things just cost less when we had America First leadership.
    - Inflation was 1.4% when the Biden Administration took office.
    - Gasoline cost \$2.39 per gallon.
    - Prices have gone up 3% more than peoples' paychecks.



## **IMMIGRATION**

- **★** There is no question, America has a crisis at the southern border.
  - Since the Biden Administration has taken office **11 million illegal immigrants** have entered the U.S.
    - That's greater than the population of 38 states.
    - Biden is on pace to allow more illegal immigrants into the country in each of the last 3 years, than all four years of the Trump Administration combined.
- **★** The American people are rightfully concerned about the Biden Administration's border crisis.
  - The border crisis/immigration ranks as the **second most important issue to voters**—only trailing the economy.
  - **Only 1-in-4 Americans** think Joe Biden is doing a better job of handling the border than President Trump.
  - Joe Biden and his administration took **94 executive actions** during their first 100 days in office to undo the border security measures put into place by the Trump Administration.
  - When it comes to the border, the numbers **speak for themselves.**

# CRIME/PUBLIC SAFETY

- ★ It is not just about the economy and people's personal finances; people feel less safe now than they did prior to the pandemic.
  - More than three-quarters of Americans, including the vast majority of nearly all demographics, say the "risk of war across the globe" is worse today than in 2019.
  - More than 6-in-10, including most Independents, Blacks, Hispanics, Moms, and suburban voters, say crime and public safety, the situation at the U.S.-Mexico border, the U.S. reputation and standing in the world, and global terrorism are *worse* today than they were in 2019.



- ★ Just turn on TV News; it's no wonder many people feel unsafe right now.
  - **Half of Americans (49%)** believe President Trump did a better job of handling crime than Joe Biden.
    - It was Joe Biden and the radical Left that supported "defund the police."
    - It was Joe Biden and the radical Left that let **criminals out of jail** without posting bond.
    - It was Kamala Harris and others on the radical Left who fundraised to get BLM protesters out of jail in the summer of 2020.
  - Americans should never forget the image of illegal migrants who allegedly attacked NYPD
    officers, walking out of jail without posting bail, and flipping the bird to Americans before
    fleeing to California.
  - People feel less safe and definitely less safe in big cities than they did under the previous administration.
    - Washington, D.C., had the highest number of homicides since 1997—up 36% from 2022.
    - Kansas City recorded its deadliest year on record.
    - Homicides in Chicago are up more than 23% compared to 2019.
    - Murders in New York City are up 23.1% from 2019 levels.
  - It's not just murders and aggravated assaults but car theft, retail theft, and many other crimes that are out of control due to the Biden Administration's soft-on-crime policies.
    - Nationwide, the U.S. experienced near-record levels of auto theft.
  - In many areas, you can't even go to the store because things are locked behind locked cases, or the stores closed because of theft.
    - One-quarter of retailers reported closing at least one location due to retail crime, while nearly half reduced operating hours.
    - Nearly two-thirds of small business owners said they have had to increase prices to compensate for losses due to retail theft.



# **IF PRESSED**

- **★** The economy was a mess when Joe Biden entered office.
  - Hogwash. Inflation was 1.4%. Gas prices were \$2.39 per gallon. Jobs were coming back from the pandemic. Recall that former Obama Treasury Secretary Lawrence Summers warned the Biden administration its unnecessary COVID-19 relief bill would cause inflation. They ignored him. Historic inflation followed a few months later.
- **★** The only thing the Trump Administration did for the economy was pass massive tax cuts for billionaires and corporations.
  - Not true. According to a <u>study</u> of IRS tax data, people with an income below \$50,000 received a 16% tax cut. People making \$50,000-\$100,000 received a 15% tax cut. And people making \$100,000-\$500,000 received a 12% cut. Those tax cuts are double the tax relief that people making more than a million dollars received.
- **★** Congress needs to act to fix the problems at the border.
  - Nonsense. The Biden Administration signed 94 executive actions during the first 100 days to undo the border security measures of the previous administration. For example, Congress changed no laws between December 2020 and December 2023. Our country had 40,000 illegal immigrants come across the southern border in 2020 compared to 302,000 crossings in 2023. The administration created this problem without Congress, and they can fix it without Congress.
- \* Republicans in Congress blocked the Biden Administration's request for more border patrol officers.
  - The Biden Administration and the so-called bipartisan bill requested more funding for officers to process illegal immigrants into our country, not deter them. The House passed a measure in 2023 (HR2) that would actually secure the border, but the Senate refuses to take it up for a vote.
- Conservatives don't support police; they attacked them on January 6.
  - January 6 was a dark day, but there is no comparison with the summer 2020 BLM riots, which, according to media analysis, resulted in 15 times more injured police officers, 19 times as many arrests, and an estimated 740 times more damages than those on January 6.
